



# THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS

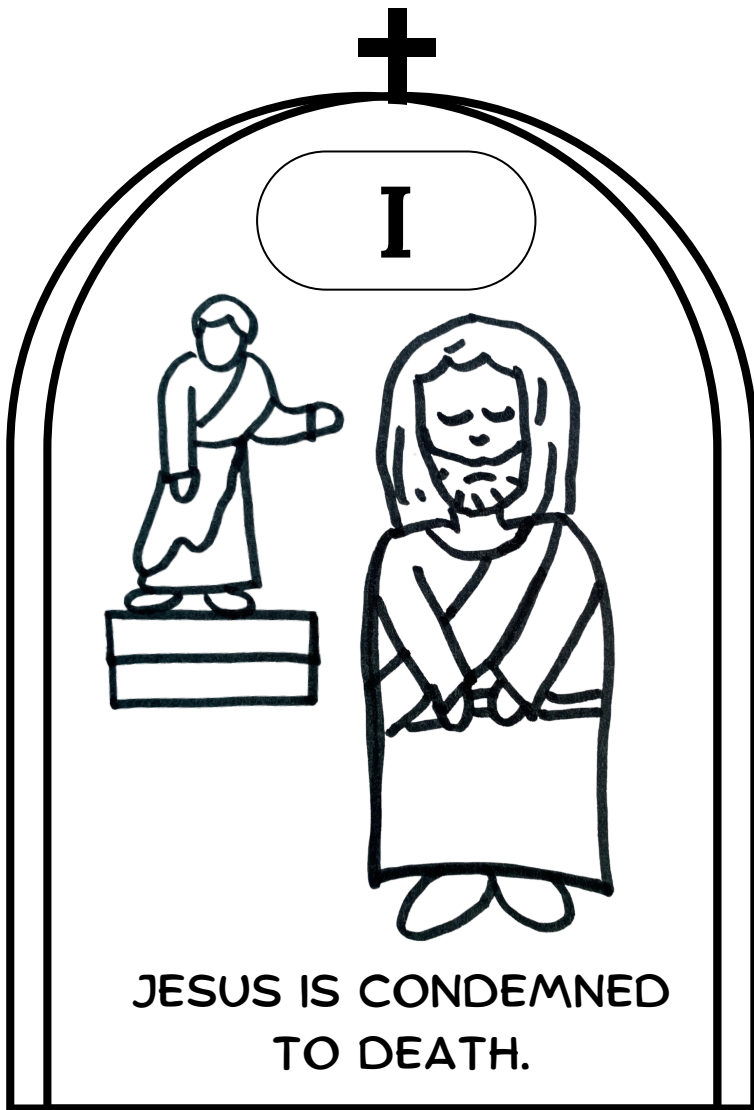

# 3RD STATION



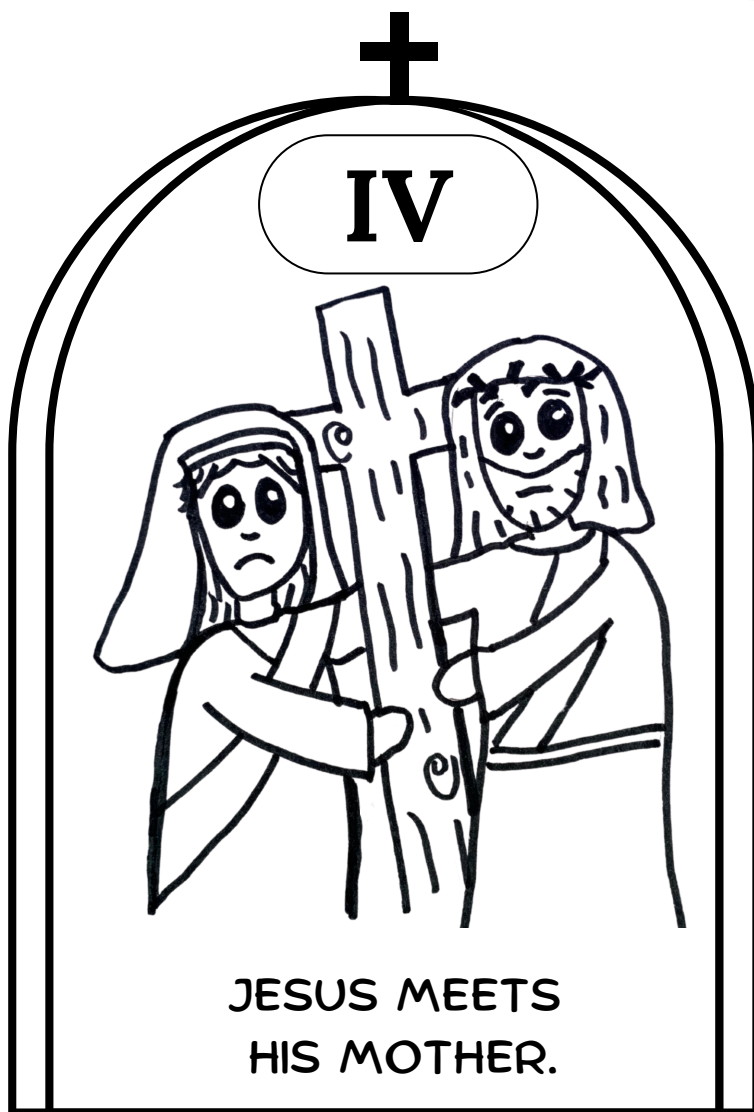
When Jesus

What can I do?

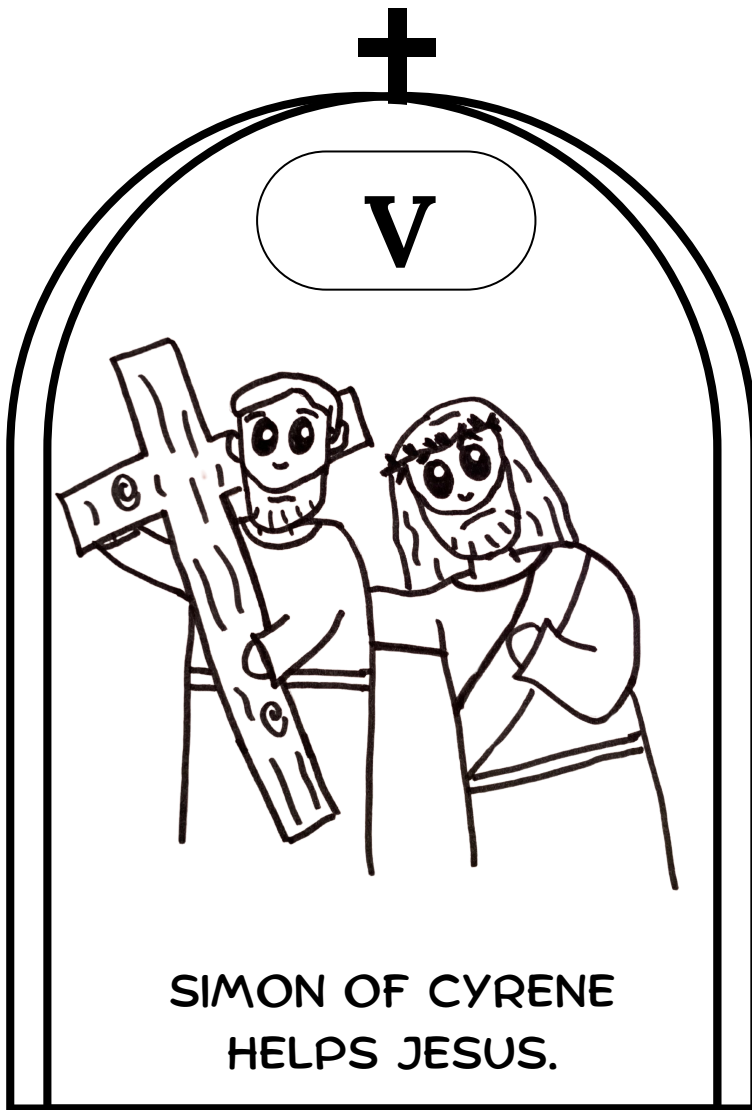


Love your parents.

# 5TH STATION



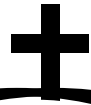
Jesus was struggling so the soldiers ordered **Simon** to help. He didn't come to help but later he **was glad** he did.

What can I do?



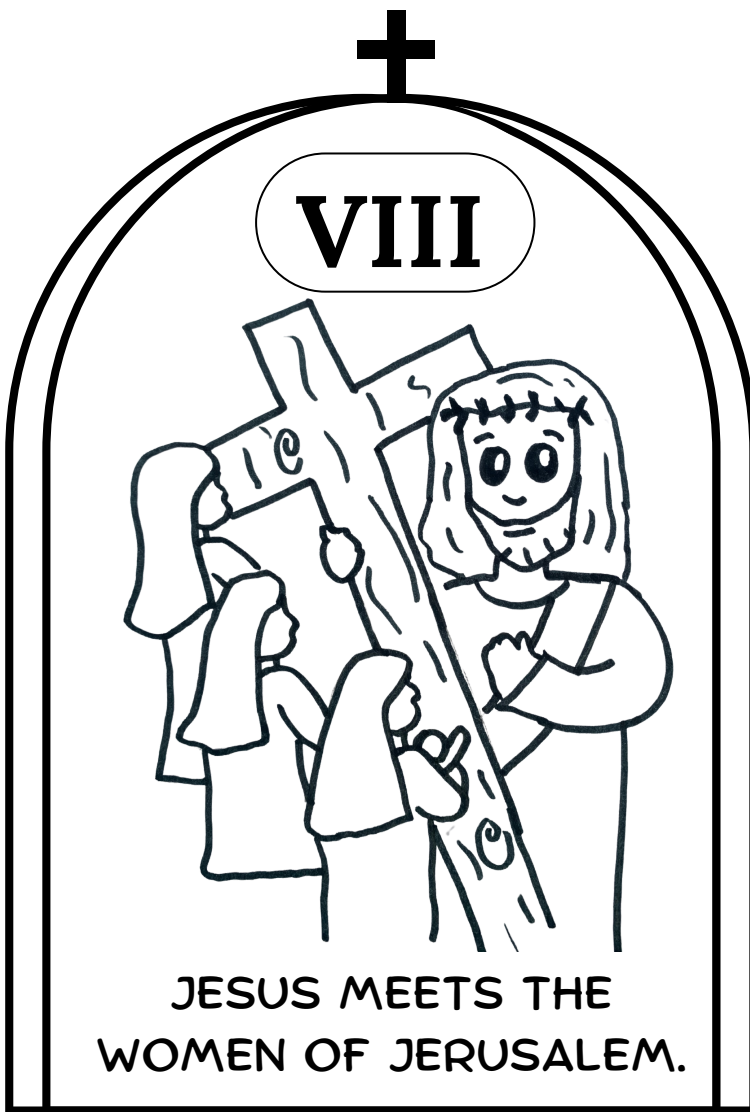
Do not give up.

# 8TH STATION



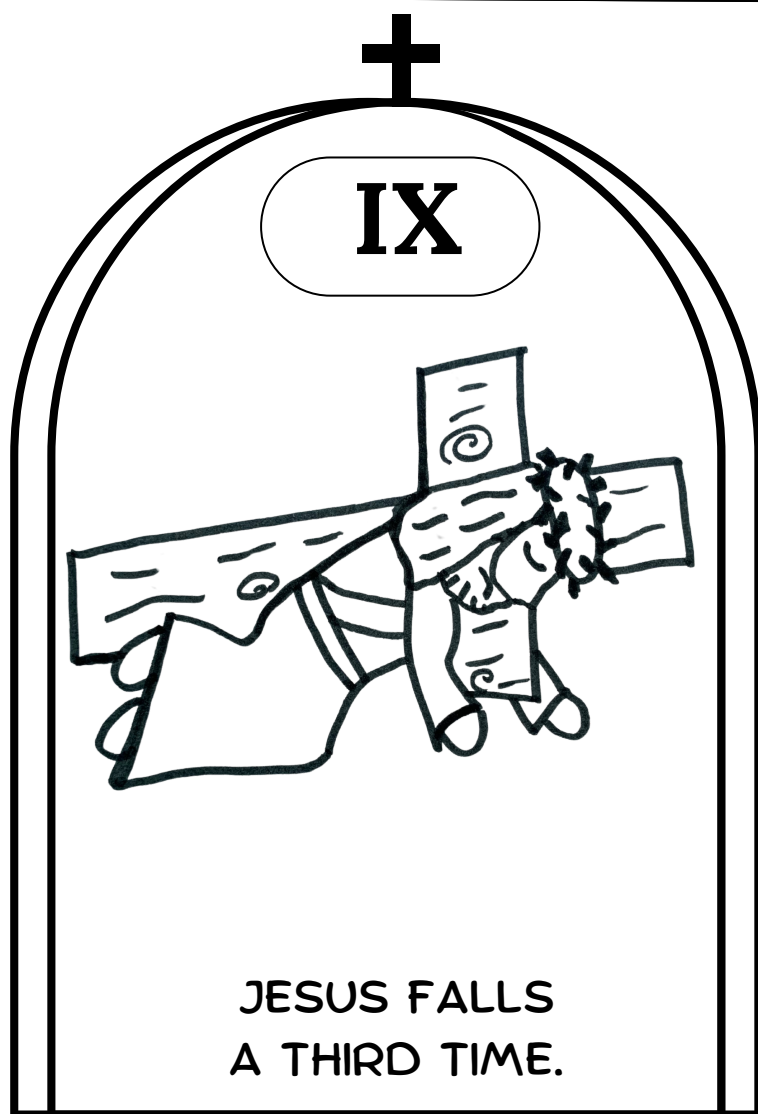
Some women came to support Jesus. He stops to talk to these women who were his **faithful friends**.

# 9TH STATION



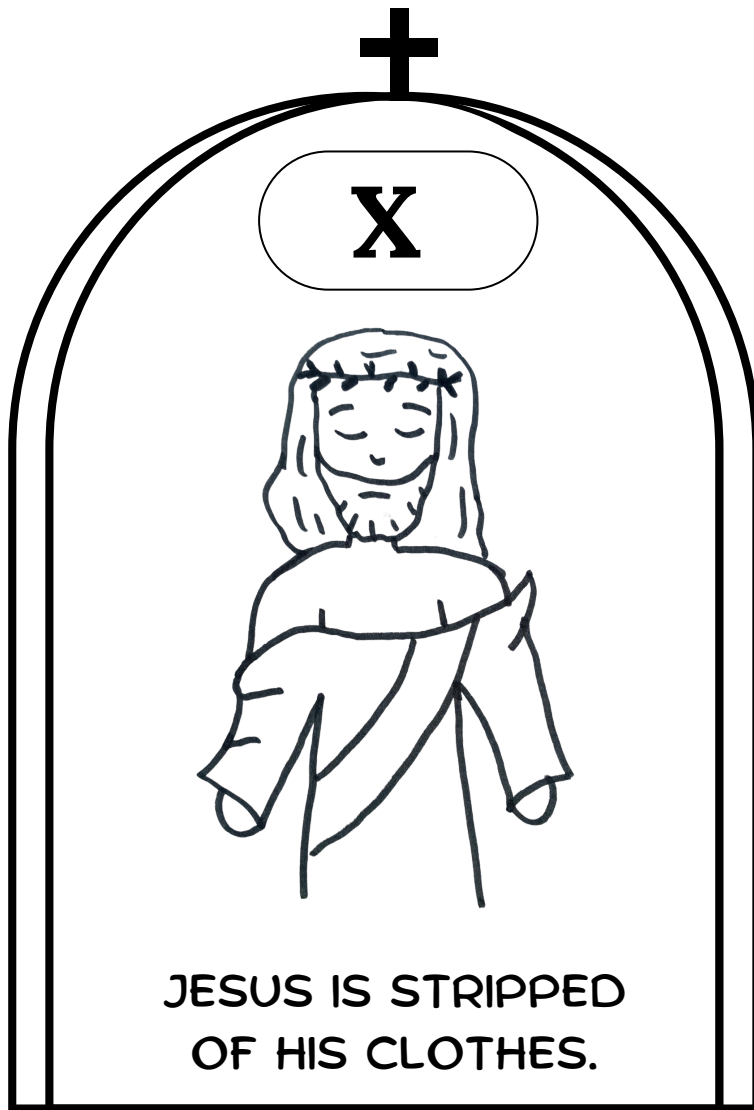
Jesus fell again and the soldiers didn't help, they just yelled at him. Jesus didn't get mad, he **forgave them.**

To be without clothes in front of a crowd of people is embarrassing.

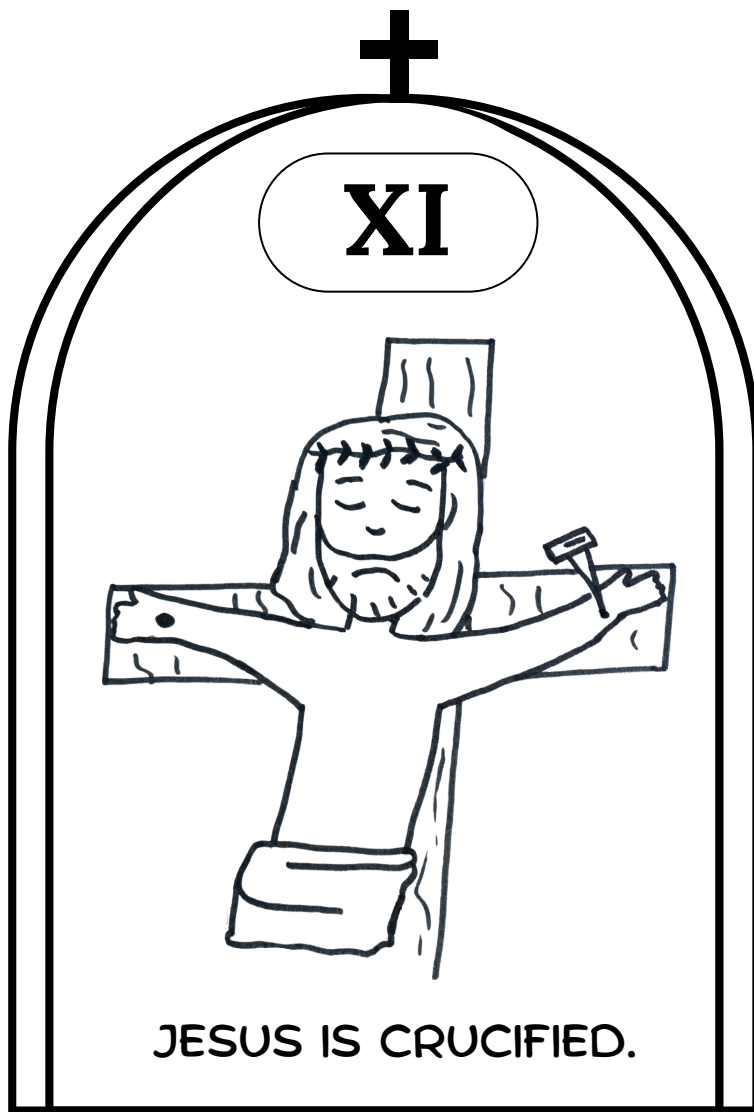
Jesus wasn't ashamed because he **knew God loved him.**

# 11TH STATION

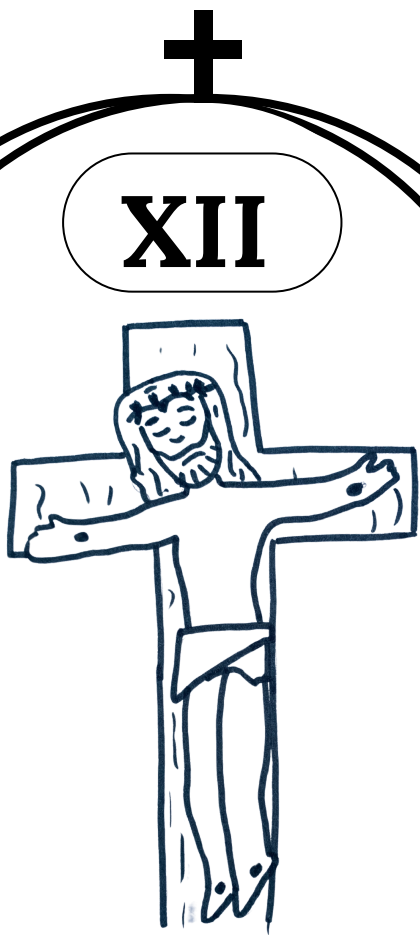


The soldiers put Jesus on the cross and nailed his hands and feet. Jesus was in pain.

ON THE CROSS.

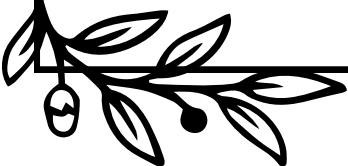
When **Jesus** died, the ground shook and the curtain in the temple ripped. This made people realize Jesus **was innocent.**

# 13TH STATION



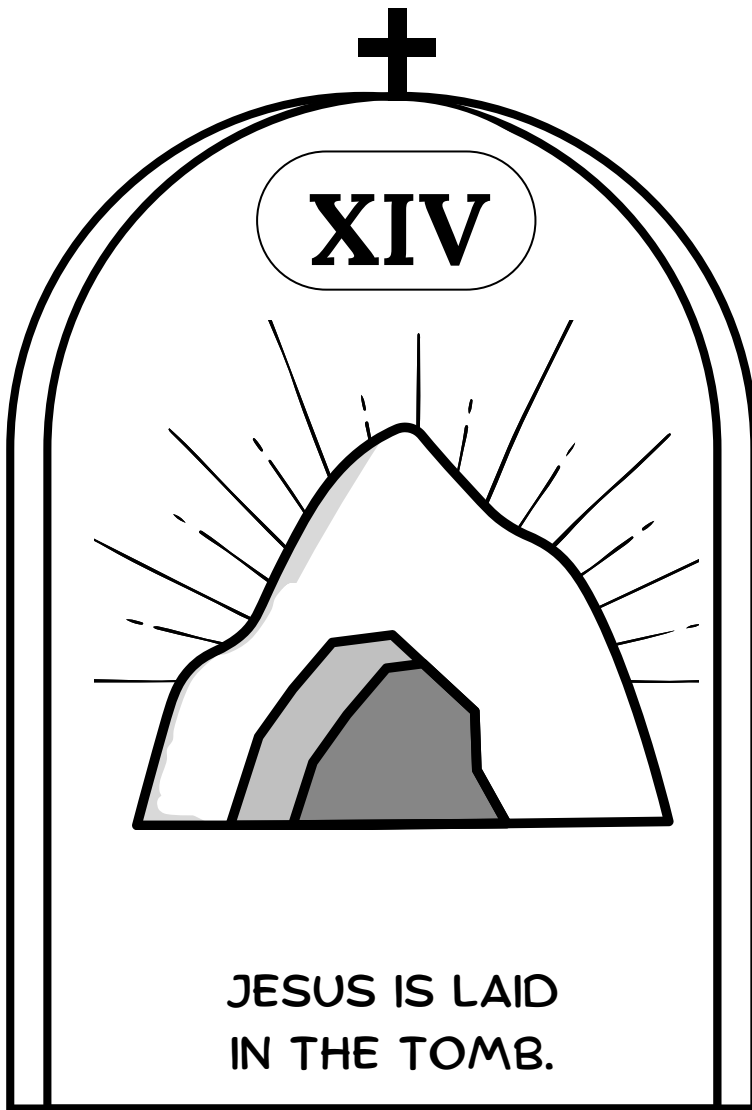
Joseph of
